Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As most have already aware, we are embarking on an ambitious plan of renewal for Spirit of Joy. The first step on this journey is embarking on a capital campaign to transform the building and grounds so that we may be positioned to serve our God and our community well into the future.

Spirit of Joy Church was opened in its current location nearly fifteen years ago. Many hours of hard work was needed by the congregation at that time to transform a bowling alley into our present worship space. Great use has been made of it serving the community and our own members in many different ways.

However, the time has come for us do all the things that are necessary to ensure that the facility will be able to meet the needs of our mission for the next fifteen years. There is much work that needs to be done. Some, such as the roof and parking lot, will be quite expensive, yet quite necessary. Others, with the aid of our members, will be far less expensive but no less impactful. These include such things as painting of the interior, renovating the bookstore and welcome areas, and renovating Linman Hall.

As envisioned, the campaign will last three years, but divided into six month segments. Each segment will have its own set of renovation/renewal goals with a specific financial target to accomplish those goals. Our emphasis will be to establish areas where our collective efforts will have the most impact for the least amount of financial support. To this end, we hope to accomplish the following in the first step of the campaign:

- Paint all public areas excluding offices and bathrooms
- Renovate the bookstore into an information and welcome center
- Renovate Linman Hall

To realize this, the financial goal is \$25,000 over the next six months. In addition to the money, a great deal of time and talent by the congregation will be required to transform these spaces. As it was in the beginning, this is a journey that will transform not only our facility, but our congregation by preparing us for what is our mission of doing God's work here in Orlando.
